

Betrayer

(A harmonization of Matthew 26:21-25; Mark 14:18-21; Luke 22:21-23; John 13:21-30 by John MacArthur.)

When Jesus had said those things, as they sat and ate, He was troubled in spirit, and testified and said, “Most assuredly, I say to you, one of you who eats with me will betray me. behold, the hand of my betrayer is with Me on the table.”

Then the disciples looked at one another, perplexed about whom He spoke. They began to question among themselves, which of them it was who would do this thing. Now there was leaning on Jesus’ bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved. Simon Peter therefore motioned to him to ask who it was of whom He spoke. Then leaning back on Jesus’ breast, he said to Him, “Lord, who is it? And they were exceeding sorrowful, and each of them began to say to Him, one by one, “Lord, is it I?” And another said, “Is it I?”

Jesus answered and said to them, “It is one of the twelve, who dips with Me in the dish, to whom I shall give a piece of bread when I have dipped it. The Son of Man indeed goes just as it is written of Him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he hadn’t been born.” Then Judas, who was betraying Him, answered and said, “Rabbi, is it I?” He said to him, “You have said it.”

And having dipped the bread, He gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. Now after the piece of bread, Satan entered into him. Then Jesus said to him, “What you do, do quickly.” But no one at the table knew for what reason He said this to him. For some thought, because Judas had the money box, that Jesus had said to him, “Buy those things we need for the feast,” or that he should give something to the poor. Having received the piece of bread, he then went out immediately. And it was night.
