

Labor Pains In the Church Family

Paul's letter to the Galatian church was a painful one for him to write, as the following excerpt shows. Paul was at odds with the church because they had given in to false teachers and given up their freedom in Christ. Aware of the context of this passage, read the following with understanding and empathy.

¹⁵ Where is that joyful and grateful spirit you felt then? I am sure you would have taken out your own eyes and given them to me if it had been possible. ¹⁶ Have I now become your enemy because I am telling you the truth?

¹⁷ Those false teachers are so eager to win your favor, but their intentions are not good. They are trying to shut you off from me so that you will pay attention only to them. ¹⁸ If someone is eager to do good things for you, that's all right; but let them do it all the time, not just when I'm with you.

¹⁹Oh, my dear children! I feel as if I'm going through labor pains for you again, and they will continue until Christ is fully developed in your lives. ²⁰I wish I were with you right now so I could change my tone. But at this distance I don't know how else to help you. (Galatians 4:15-20)

Paul lamented the influence these false teachers had on the church, for they robbed the church of their JOYFUL AND GRATEFUL SPIRIT. This is always the result when legalistic people have their way in a church. The genuine emotions of people are bled away in a search for "dignity" and dedication to traditions whose original meaning and significance is lost, though the empty forms are still observed. I believe when worship occurs, different emotions will be felt. The presence of these emotions is not an achievement, but they are a blessing and a sign we are on the right track.

False teachers are always fake teachers; they are self-condemned by their hypocrisy. We've often heard hypocrisy used by unbelievers and non-attenders as an excuse for not believing and not attending. Shame on us: instead of outsiders, Jesus' people ought to be the most vocal critics of hypocrisy, just as He was.

Paul did not use the image of LABOR PAINS to exaggerate his feelings about the church. He intended to give them a "gut level connection" to express how deeply he loved them, an affection the false teachers did not share. A hypocrite may sound "biblically correct" because they love law and order, but the truth is, they only love law and order to advance their ambitions.

Paul's genuine love for the members gave him a desire to take a more positive approach to them, but they had thrown away their freedom with both hands so God prevailed on Paul to bring discipline on them instead. We must be realistic and flexible to follow God's leading. There are times a positive approach fails to achieve God's will and a disciplinary approach must be used. May we have wisdom from God to know the difference and courage from God to do the right thing regardless of the sacrifice required. **Lincoln Unruh** - son of Nathan & Sarah Unruh and greatgrandson of Joy Ingalls graduating from Grand Canyon Christian University in Phoenix, AZ.
