

Meet Rev. Dr. Kimberly La Plante



It all began at the tender age of five during a VBS gathering titled "Round Up for Jesus." I dedicated my life to Jesus, igniting a deep love for God. The church became my home. I would sit beside my grandmother, gazing up at an illuminated sign over the pulpit that read, "Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit," says the Lord of Hosts,

Zechariah 4:6, and I believed God could do anything. This was the beginning of a call that would take me all over the world and across the street. My story has been woven by my life verse which comes from Isaiah 6:1-3, which Jesus also quoted in Luke 4:16-21. My heartfelt mission has always been to bring transformation by the Spirit of God to those who are broken, weary, and wounded. I have witnessed God take those in captivity and free them. Those who are dying come alive once more, and those who are broken become whole.

I've spent over twenty years working in pastoral and community settings, and I've gathered quite a bit of experience along the way. I earned a Doctorate of Ministry in Transformational Leadership for the Global City from Bakke Graduate School, a Master of Arts in Divinity focusing on Pastoral Counseling from Sioux Falls Seminary, and a

Bachelor of Arts in Business Management from the University of Sioux Falls. Currently, I'm the Connections Coordinator at Volunteers of America for a Title One school. Before this,

I was the Director of Community Engagement at the Multi-Cultural Center and previously I served as a Chaplain at the South Dakota Women's Prison. Before this, I founded and directed Tapestry International in Los Angeles and Call to Freedom in Sioux Falls, where I built transformative communities and worked with partners to tackle social justice issues, especially human trafficking. My pastoral journey began by pastoring at an American Baptist Church in Madison, South Dakota, for seven years, where our congregation grew, and I was ordained by the American Baptist Churches of the USA.

I love to preach, teach, write and create art inspired by faith and the Word. I cherish nature, spiritual growth, old hymns, and learning from diverse cultures. I get great joy from witnessing people embrace God's love, seeing prayers answered, and walking alongside others as they grow in Christ.
