

Don’t use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good or helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

“I guess Tim must be pretty impressed with my carpentry skills,” the pastor thought, noticing his neighbor was hanging around much longer than usual. “Well, I’ll show him a thing or two about working with wood,” he mused.

Finally, the last board was attached and the pastor stood back to admire his work. Turning to Tim he said, “What do you think, Tim?”

The boy shrugged his shoulders. “It’s OK, I guess.” He seemed strangely noncommittal for having spent several minutes watching the pastor work. Pastor Dave was curious.

“Oh. I thought you were standing there admiring my carpentry.”

“Naw,” said Tim. I was waiting to see what a preacher said when he hit his thumb with a hammer.”

Even when we think we’re alone, we must realize people are listening. They are eager to see that our words match our claims to know Jesus. Most of them are happy when they do match.

We are commanded to choose our words carefully, aiming to encourage one another. Coarse words, rude language, and rough talk do not encourage devotion to Christ: they tend to disappoint those who hear us virtually deny our faith.
