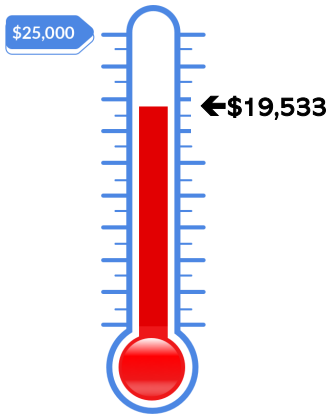

### How shall we celebrate?

Emmanuel Baptist Church was organized on August 7, 1921 for the purpose of planting a Baptist church on the east side of Sioux Falls. We find ourselves, 100 years later, with a great heritage of faith to celebrate. To give thanks to God and to enjoy this achievement, it is up to us to organize some sort of celebration.

At the moment, we are hopeful the pandemic will not pose a barrier to the observance of our centennial. We can make plans with increasing confidence that we will be able to carry them out.

What follows is simply a set of suggestions. Read through the list, then assess what you feel lead to do to help get organized.

Sunday, August 1, 9:30 am - Opening Worship Service to feature former pastors, staffers, interns, and people we've ordained. We will dedicate and put our new Bibles to use.

Monday, August 2, 7:00 pm - "Scrap Book Day." We'll serve a "Dessert Potluck" and have a projector to show photos and share memories.

Tuesday, August 3, 4:00 pm - "Women's Day." The Ladies will have a "Tea Time" event, honoring women who have served Emmanuel Baptist Church, starting with our founder, Helen Tenhaven.

Wednesday, August 4, 5:00 pm - "Community Day." Serving treats from local bakers, we will invite our community to come in and tour the church. We will share this day with Lunch is Served.

Thursday, August 5, 7:00 pm - "Concert Day." We will have a concert and hymn-sing, featuring our musicians and guests who have blessed us musically throughout the years.

Friday, August 6, 6:00 pm - "Men's Day." Our men will serve a cook-out meal with our neighbors as the honored guests.

Saturday, August 7, 11:00 am - "ABC/D Day." We will invite pastors and lay people from our sister churches to come and bring greetings, then have a luncheon.

Sunday, August 8, 9:30 am - Closing Worship Service: "ABC/USA Day" with the keynote message delivered by our General Secretary (or replacement). A catered dinner will be served.

The first question is: do you see anything on this list with which you feel lead to help organize? How will you contribute?

It is my hope each event will be "self-contained," having its own committee to plan and execute it, paying for itself by accepting donations or selling tickets. I prefer to keep preparations decentralized. That way, if any of the events does not have support from our members and friends, we will drop it from the schedule.
