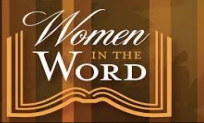

Why is this Happening?

How do we find ourselves in this situation? How were some elected leaders so prepared to exercise unprecedented authority when the pandemic suddenly appeared? How is it that riots accompany every election, disaster, or tragedy? Why do enemy nations think they can act with impunity against us and our allies? Why do the “solutions” offered in Washington, DC drive us deeper into debt and enlarge an already bloated bureaucracy?

Here is the short answer to all these questions: there are Americans who believe America needs to be broken so they can “fix” it according to their Marxist beliefs. These events are the result of the work of various groups who are trying to break the system (our government and our culture) by overwhelming it with problems. I don’t believe there is a conspiracy at work, other than the fact that Satan is the “father of all lies” (John 8:44). But there is one belief system that guides these bad actors, and it is Marxism. Marxism is one of the two most powerful lies of the modern Age. The other lie is Darwinism.

Karl Marx’s philosophy divided people down economic lines. He saw history as being a record of the struggle between the “haves” and the “have nots.” He believed equality and justice had to be achieved by means of revolution and it didn’t matter how many were killed or how much chaos ensued. Communism is the most faithful application of Marx’s teaching. History’s verdict on communism is complete failure causing untold suffering with an antagonistic attitude toward religion and all forms of freedom.

Here are four forms of American Marxism:

Economic Marxism is the “classic” form of Marxism that divides people in economic classes. They are attempting to break the system by enlarging the federal debt, increasing inflation, illegal immigration, and confiscatory taxes.

Environmental Marxism divides people by their level of ecological concern. They use “man-made climate change” to oppose industrial and technological progress, blaming capitalism. Science does not support the top-heavy measures they endorse.

Ethnic Marxism divides people by their skin color and associated cultural differences. This kind of Marxist uses “Critical Race Theory” to attempt to break the system, condemning America as prejudicial and oppressive from its founding.

Sexual Marxism divides people by their sexual preference. They are attempting to break our families and our culture’s morals by sanctioning sexual sin especially with “transgenderism.”

There are three levels of American Marxists.

- The leaders are hypocritical, cynical, and corrupt persons who use these movements for personal financial and political gain.
- The influencers propagate the movement and are more “sincere believers,” utilizing education and media to make converts.
- The remainder are people who have accepted uncritically what they are told by leaders and influencers, falling prey to the false teaching and false promises the Marxists have made.

Do not let any of this discourage you as the ultimate outcome is clear: BUT YOU BELONG TO GOD, MY DEAR CHILDREN. YOU HAVE ALREADY WON A VICTORY OVER THOSE PEOPLE, BECAUSE THE SPIRIT WHO LIVES IN YOU IS GREATER THAN THE SPIRIT WHO LIVES IN THE WORLD. THOSE PEOPLE BELONG TO THIS WORLD, SO THEY SPEAK FROM THE WORLD’S VIEWPOINT, AND THE WORLD LISTENS TO THEM. BUT WE BELONG TO GOD, AND THOSE WHO KNOW GOD LISTEN TO US. IF THEY DO NOT BELONG TO GOD, THEY DO NOT LISTEN TO US. THAT IS HOW WE KNOW IF SOMEONE HAS THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH OR THE SPIRIT OF DECEPTION. (1 John 4:4-6)

God’s word requires us to respect those who govern us and obey the laws of the land (see Romans 13:1-7). At the same time, Scripture commands us to TEST THE SPIRITS (1 John 4:1); to exercise discernment to recognize the true spiritual nature of persons and movements and react appropriately.

Our response must begin in the Spirit (Ephesians 6:10-18). Prayer and Scripture are our most valuable weapons in this battle. We must learn the truth to counter the deceits of the various kinds of Marxists and take our stand against their lies.
