### **Better than Recovery**

Maybe, like me, you're weary of hearing about damage done by the pandemic, people lamenting what's been lost since the lockdowns. We need to grieve; that's understandable but we need to move on too. What bothers me is the sense of inevitability, assuming things will continue to get worse.

We may be asking the wrong question. Try asking, "Might we be better off letting go of an idealized and false memory of our past to live more faithfully in the present? Can we do better than just recover?"

Restore to me the joy of your salvation and make me willing to obey you. - Psalm 51:12 (NLT)

Step One = Pray for JOY. Salvation is good news and people are more eager than ever for good news. This joy is something God gives, not something we create.

Step Two = Have JOY motivate our OBEDIENCE. Nothing about our life of faith is to be done grudgingly. All of it is obedience to God's will. Though we must face difficulties and opposition, obeying God in the daily details of life is joy.

I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made it grow. It's not important who does the planting, or who does the watering. What's important is that God makes the seed grow. - 1 Corinthians 3:6-7

Step Three = Know your role. Paul was the seed planter. He was the evangelist, the one who started the church. Apollos was the worker who came later and watered, proving all the care the seed needed to thrive.

Step Four = Do your job. Paul and Apollos were faithful to exercise their roles in the church. The growth was God's doing. When we are faithful to serve, God will make the church grow in His way and in His time.

Things have changed. Our jobs of planting and watering will look different from what they were in the past. What remains the same is the word (the Bible) and the Spirit. We need to remain in them.

Strategically, the old approach in a new environment requires us to do the following.

- Be genuine. We're all more cynical because we've all been manipulated. Tell the truth and the whole truth, so God will help you.
- Use technology to gain a hearing but be personal. Be real and available; use "Facetime" to try to create face-to-face time.
- Supply hope and share joy. We are to be the happy bearers of GOOD NEWS. If you received joy in step one, give it away again!
- Work together. All of us are needed. Partner up to enjoy fellowship and do service.
